The User is responsible for adherence to all requirements of EPA and DOT regulations as outlined below. Only RCRA empty IBCs will be accepted for reprocessing or recycling.

1. The above person is responsible for meeting the **Requirements of 40 CFR §261.7**
 - a. All IBCs must be cleaned to remove all hazardous wastes and materials to the extent possible using common practices.
 - b. No more than 0.3% of the container capacity by weight is allowable except
 - c. P-listed chemicals just be triple rinsed with a solvent capable of removing the residue and drip dried. P-listed hazardous chemicals can be found in 40 CFR § 261.33. Acute hazards requiring rinsing are listed in §§ 261.31-261.33
2. The above person is responsible for meeting the **Requirements of 49 CFR §§107-180 and specifically § 173.29** below
 - a. All openings must be closed
 - b. All labels and markings must be in place as if the container contained its greater quantity of its original material
 - c. Trucks must be placarded with the original material and have the required shipping papers filled out. The Shipper is required to follow all local, state, and federal guidelines and regulations relative to the shipment of these containers and the material they had contained.
